

MYSTERY GUEST COMES TO SUPPER


(Emmaus) — A strange thing happened on the way to this small town not far from the big city of Jerusalem. Two men, who had been friends of Jesus before he died, were walking home to Emmaus. On the way they met a man who walked along with them. They didn't know who the mysterious stranger was, but they found out he was interested in the latest news. The news was that Jesus, after he had been killed on the cross, had come back from the dead and was amazing people by appearing to them.

The stranger explained to the two men how the Scriptures had promised it would happen. Then when the three of them arrived at Emmaus, the men asked the stranger to stay for supper. As the guest broke bread they would be eating, the hosts may have remembered a miracle with loaves of bread — or a supper with bread in the Upper Room in Jerusalem. Suddenly they recognized Jesus' voice and knew he was really alive again!


