lamps shine, but it shines inside of us and makes us feel warm and loved.

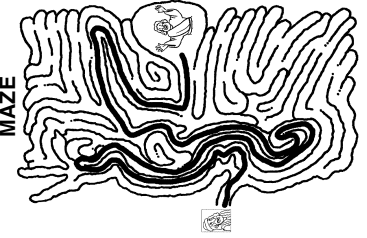
